


# I AM PATIENT SAFETY

David has worked with the hospital's falls committee and natural sleep initiative team to reduce patient falls due to certain medications. He was also instrumental in improving patient safety in the neonatal intensive care unit by demonstrating how staff can use electronic ordering plans efficiently, rebuilding the unit's pump libraries to maximize safety software and educating staff pharmacists on properly compounding medications. David has also led the effort to establish an antibiotic stewardship program to minimize the use of antibiotics and reduce *Clostridium difficile* (C. diff) rates. He also developed electronic order pathways to help prescribers avoid harmful drug interactions when ordering new oral anticoagulants. David's efforts to improve gaps in Einstein's communication systems have encouraged all who work with him to seek his expertise and recommendations.
